Training Program in Biodefense and Emerging Infectious Diseases

This is an interdisciplinary program, funded by the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Disease (NIAID), to prepare the next generation of scientists who will develop integrated research programs in biodefense preparedness and response to infectious threats. Fellows will receive broad training in bioterrorist agents, emerging infectious disease, and epidemiology.

Applicants to the doctoral program may apply for a Fellowship in Biodefense and Emerging Infectious Diseases, which includes a competitive stipend, tuition, health insurance, and travel to a scientific meeting.

Candidates who wish to apply for this fellowship must be either a US citizen or a permanent resident, and must submit a brief essay discussing their interests and outlining their goals in the area of biodefense and emerging infectious diseases.
